Crystal and I are continually thankful for the Lord's provision throughout our time on deputation. The Lord has allowed us to travel the many miles in safety and with good health, and every need along the way has been provided. On Thanksgiving Day, I was especially thankful that we were able to spend time with our families.

Prayer Request

My dad's health has been a continual prayer request for the last several months, and I am thankful to you for praying! Since our last update, my dad went to the doctor to get a CT scan with contrast; the doctor called him back with the decision that the kidney needed to be removed. On November 4th, my dad underwent surgery to have the kidney removed. The doctor saw something in the kidney that he did not expect; therefore, he took a personal interest in the pathology report. We learned that there was a cancerous tumor in the kidney (even though the biopsy taken earlier said no cancer and no infection). The doctor reported that the cancer was isolated to the kidney and that he was able to remove all the cancer. There was no need for any further treatment, such as chemo or radiation! Praise the Lord!!! Dad will need to have follow up visits every few months for a year and then once a year for the next four years before he will be considered cancer free.

Please keep my dad in prayer for surgery recovery and that he will remain cancer free.
