A Trip to the African "Busch"

The Cormier family was also excited to have the Busches visit since Bro. Andy Busch, pastor of 35 years, was one of their instructors while they were



in Bible college. While Bro. Busch was here, we were able to include him in the different areas of ministry. The beginning of June kicked off with our "Missions Month" at Karen Baptist Church.
