We thank the Lord that he has continued to preserve our safety and that the illnesses that have caught up to us have been minor and not hindered us in making the meetings previously scheduled. I happened to have been reminded earlier this month that I am no longer as young as I thought I was. I sprained my ankle (not in a sporting activity but simply because I turned quickly on slightly uneven ground), but I am grateful that the sprain was minor and that we had the time in between meetings for me to recover. A few days on crutches was sufficient recovery time for my ankle to gain most of its strength back.

Beyond the financial support that we receive from supporting churches, we are most grateful for the prayer support that we receive. Wherever we go, we have church members and pastors tell us that they have been praying for us. We also receive e-mails from churches which we have yet to visit telling us that they are specifically praying for our health and safety in travel. We want to thank you for praying for us. This past month, there were instances both in travel and in matters of health where I stopped and thanked the Lord for protecting my family and I from worst-case-scenarios. I am convinced that your prayers on our behalf have been effective. Please continue to pray for my family and I as we will be traveling to supporting churches until October. We return to Kenya in November.
