Betty did not know for sure if heaven would be her home, yet she was busy and did not have the time for us to show her how she could know for sure that her sins were forgiven and that she could become a child of God. Margaret and Josephine, in contradiction to Scripture they were shown, were trusting their works and especially their baptism in their church to get them to heaven. Using the Bible, we left them with biblical examples to consider that stood against the false doctrine they were taught. We appreciate your prayers for us as we continue to labor for souls.
